

Birdzout Gel is a long-lasting, non-poisonous, tacky bird repellent for use on ledges, sills, beams, rafters and other indoor and outdoor locations where pest birds land or roost.

When applied according to instructions, Birdzout Gel can effectively discourage pigeons, starlings, sparrows and other pest birds from roosting on or returning to a treated area for up to one year.

How this works

The gel creates a very sticky and uncomfortable surface that is unbearable to most birds, and tastes awful when they try to peck it off.

Directions for Use:

Use to discourage pigeons, starlings, sparrows, and other similar pest bird species from roosting on treated ledges, sills, peaks and similar parts of buildings and other structures.

Birdzout Gel is a transparent, sticky product that remains tacky at -10° C and will not run at temperatures up to 90° C.

Application Directions:

Clean surfaces to be treated. Wipe or scrape all dirt and other loose debris from surfaces.

Use a standard caulking gun to apply this product. Remove cap then carefully cut off the tip of plastic nozzle on top of tube. Insert a screwdriver or extension rod on caulk gun to puncture seal.

Press against surface to ensure good adhesion. Apply beads of repellent no larger than 12mm wide.

For smaller birds apply a narrower bead, to ensure birds do not become entangled in the gel.

One tube will cover approx 3.5 - 7 lineal metres (depending on the size of the bead).

Birdzout Gel will last for approximately 12 months (depending on application and dust and residue in the area)



IMPORTANT NOTE:

Small birds may become fatally entrapped by this tacky repellent. Read instructions prior to use and follow all directions and precautions.

Partially Used Cartridges:

Replace cap on the tip of tube.

Product Clean-up:

Use mineral spirits / turpentine or a citrus based cleaner to remove product from treated surfaces.

Storage & Disposal:

Store locked up, in original tube in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in a rubbish bin. Keep out of lakes, ponds and streams.

First-Aid:

This product can cause substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Wear goggles or face shield. Wear gloves. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

If on skin or clothing:

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of soap and water for 15 - 20 minutes.

If in eyes:

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 - 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

If swallowed:

Immediately call a POISON CENTER or physician. Do NOT induce vomiting.

Danger:

Causes skin irritation.

May be fatal if swallowed or enters airways
